

Health & Safety Policy Statement

Bakers Waste Services Ltd are a leading waste management provider with waste transfer facilities located in Leicester and Northampton. Bakers Waste Services Ltd constantly audit operations and working procedures in order to comply with the health & safety responsibilities under the Health & Safety Work Act 1974; the Management of Health & Safety at Work Regulations 1999 and any other relevant legislation appertaining to Health & Safety law for employees and additional persons affected by the company's operations.

The company recognises its responsibilities in connection with the provision of adequate facilities and health & safety controls in order to prevent the occurrence of ill health & accidents on site.

The company has developed mitigation techniques in order to eliminate/reduce ill health and accidents causing injury, which include input from top level management and employees.

Bakers Waste are committed to the following:


- Maintain a health & safety management system to the principles of the OHSAS 18001 standard.
- To take into consideration all legal and other requirements to which the organisation subscribes and ensure compliance.
- To implement corrective/preventative measures for all risks assessed as significant for customers, employees, visitors and suppliers/contractors.
- To ensure that all employees receive instruction, training & information in line with significant risks of the organisation.
- To use results obtained from historical and regular site audits in order to improve health & safety on site and to develop sound monitoring and tracking systems for tracking progress.
- To monitor accident, incidents and potential incident trends across the organisation and make continual improvements.

The responsibility for maintenance of the policy and assurance of a safe working environment resides with Managing Director Paul Baker, but may be delegated to any other applicable Director where necessary. The communication of this policy will be to all stakeholders of the organisation via the organisations website, notice boards, procedures and hard copy where applicable.

This policy will be communicated in a variety of ways including but not limited to working procedures, visual display material such as posters and site rules.

In addition to the above Bakers Waste Services Ltd will commit to a programme of continuous improvement in health & safety management and performance for the prevention of injury and ill health.

This policy and the organisations objectives and targets will be reviewed annually or in the event of organisational accidents or incidents or where new practices introduced within the organisation require a change in the policy.
